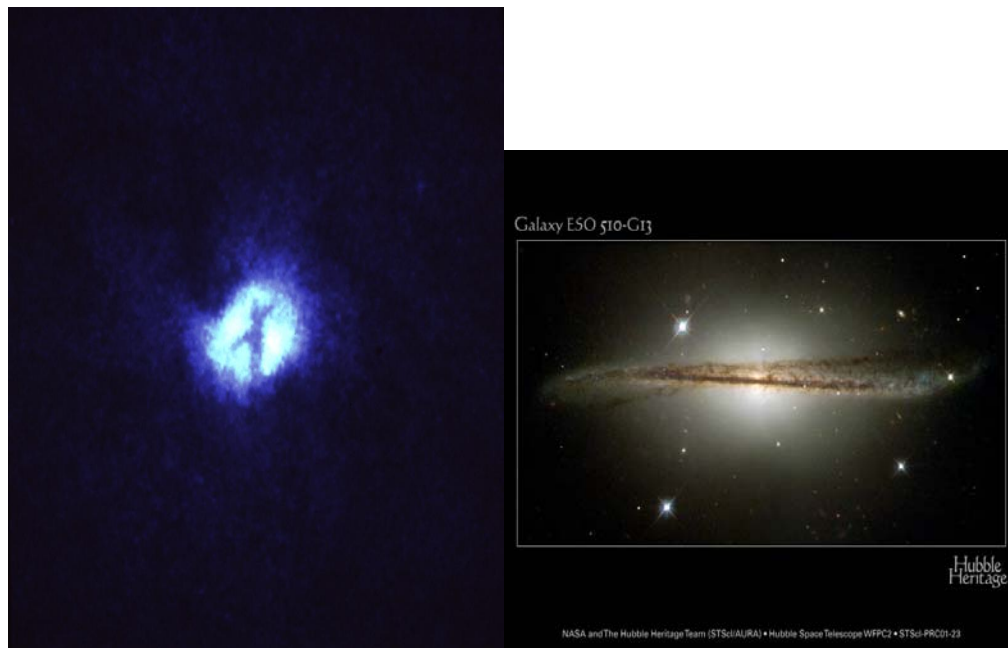
- Discover who you are in Christ – your unique personality, gift-mix and passions

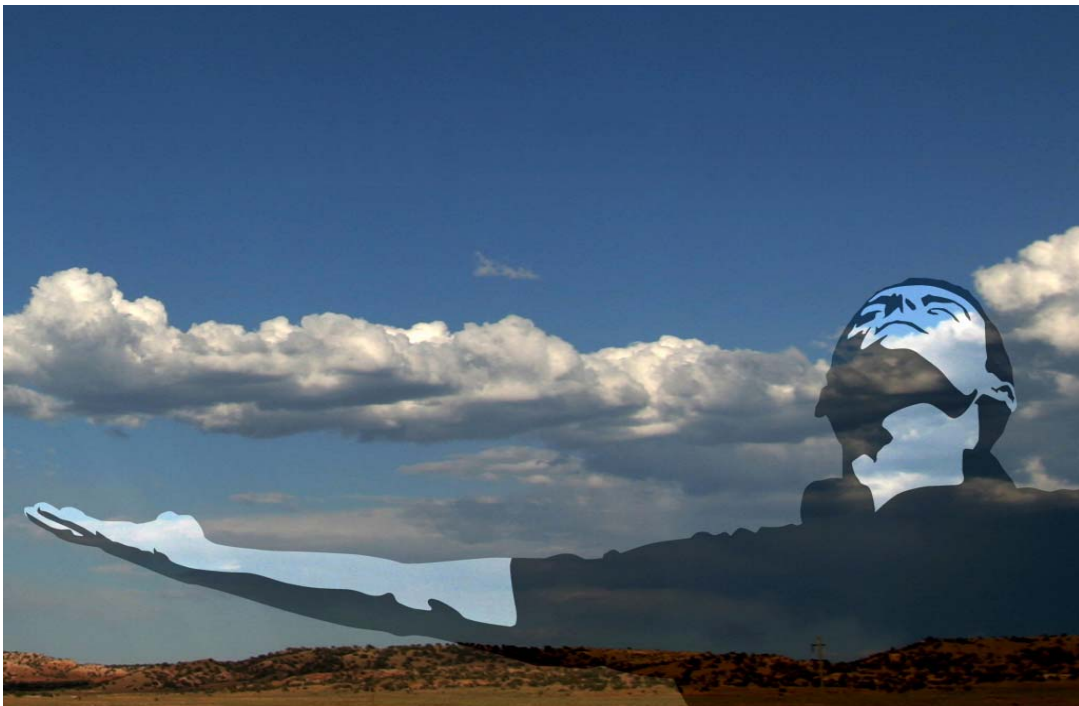
